

Paekakariki Services Club Charitable Trust

Information Sheet

In 1997, members of the former Paekakariki Services Club resolved to establish a charitable trust, which was formalised in 1998. The principle purpose of the Trust is to provide financial assistance within the Paekakariki district for charitable purposes. Particular emphasis is to be placed on the following:

- > the education of children;
- > social and physical development of children through school sporting activities at school;
- > teaching children to swim;
- > surf lifesaving activities, limited to the saving of lives and water safety; and
- > recreation facilities for people 'in need' due to age, poverty, disablement or infirmity.

Criteria

To be eligible for funding from the Trust, applications must:

- > of a charitable or educational nature;
- > based within the Paekakariki district;
- > self-supporting and not solely reliant on the Paekakariki Services Club Charitable Trust.

Applications are considered by the Trustees. As a guide to applicants, a total of \$14,000 is available for granting this year.

General

Decisions regarding grants made are on the basis of information provided in the application and other enquiries. The information provided by your organisation becomes the property of the Paekakariki Services Club Charitable Trust and may be made available to other parties in the course of enquiries regarding the applications or in publishing the results of grants approved.

It is important that details on the attached application form should be concise and easy to read.

Applications need to include:

- > Supporting information such as proposal, budget for the year, copy of quotes etc.
- > Bank deposit slip for payment of successful grant.
