Charitable contributions, in the form of bequests, grants and scholarships, help to shape future generations by strengthening education, protecting our environment, supporting whānau, and preserving the richness of our culture. This type of funding allows individuals, charities, and communities to sustain their programmes, expand their activities, and reach their goals.

These are more than simply financial contributions – they are acts of love creating an intergenerational impact.

Every year, Public Trust manages hundreds of bequests and charitable grants made possible by ordinary New Zealanders who choose to leave a gift in their will.

As one of New Zealand's largest charitable trust administrators, Public Trust proudly supports efforts to foster a culture of giving. As a campaign supporter, you can join organisations across New Zealand to raise awareness of gifts in wills. For many charities, this is one of the largest single sources of funding.

In New Zealand, charities receive an estimated \$320 million annually from bequests. If more people included charitable giving in their wills, it could unlock \$2.4 billion annually in two decades.

Wills aren't just about money or property. They're about people. They're about values we pass on. A bequest can create a ripple effect that lasts for years to come. We need two things to make this happen: people to plan for the future by making a will and making the active choice to leave a gift in their will.

While there are no strict rules regarding where to use each version, we kindly request that you reproduce them in their entirety and refrain from making any alterations.



Instructions for changing text in PDF

- > Open the PDF in Adobe Acrobat
- > Access the tools panel
- Select the edit PDF tool
- > Select the text to edit
- > Edit and format the text
- > Save your changes

Instructions to add your logo in PDF

- > Open the PDF in Adobe Acrobat
- > Access the tools panel
- > Select the edit PDF tool
- > Select the add a image tool
- Adjust size and position of logo
- > Save your changes
